

**Global Impact of Drug Abuse:**

- Affected Population:** Approximately 275 million people used drugs in the past year, according to the UNODC's World Drug Report 2023.
- High Usage Regions:** The highest rates of drug use are found in North America, Europe, and parts of Asia, with significant increases observed in Africa and Latin America.
- Trends:** There has been a rise in the use of synthetic drugs, including methamphetamine and new psychoactive substances (NPS).
- Mental Health Disorders:** Drug abuse is closely linked with mental health issues such as depression, anxiety, and psychosis.
- Overdose Deaths:** There has been a dramatic increase in overdose deaths, particularly from opioids. In 2022, over 500,000 people died globally from drug-related causes.
- Disease Transmission:** Drug abuse contributes to the spread of infectious diseases, including HIV/AIDS and hepatitis C, primarily through the sharing of contaminated needles.
